## Ethnic, unique jewels handmade with a lot of love ....

I have been travelling more than hundred times for the last 35 years to Ethiopia – and some other African countries- and really fell in love with Ethiopia, their people and their handicraft.... I collected quite a lot of necklaces, then finally felt the need to create some of these beauties myself!... ALL are UNIQUE pieces, so that no one else will wear the same as you! ALL are made of traditionnal beads - stone, phenolic resin (also called false amber), silver, bone, recycled glass (handmade in Ghana), old metal/silver beads, ethiopian crosses and pendants, telsum beads, prayer beads, some other beads too ( Afghanistan, India, Tibet, Morocco) ... Some of these beads have become rare and expensive now ... ALL necklace will be sold with unique assorted earrings!! And ... just for the anecdote, " Tembu" is the Ethiopian name my friends gave me in Ethiopia ... and it means " the fat/big one", but it is supposed to be a very meaningful name there!

In these times where travels have got a lot more difficult, these items will help you travel with your mind ...
